

"It's 1918. The Great War, WWI, has been going on for over four years between the Allied and Central Powers. However, Germany is running out of resources, her allies are surrendering, and support back home is waning. The only choice is an armistice, a ceasefire. At 11 AM on the eleventh day of the eleventh month, Germany surrendered and WWI was over."

Although WWI officially ended on June 28, 1919 with the signing of the Treaty of Versailles, November II, 1918 is the day the fighting stopped, and the honoring of our veterans began. Veterans Day is always observed on the historically-significant November IIth and celebrates our veterans for their patriotism and service.

Veterans Day is an important event for us here at LPPL. Our bayou community is home to many veterans and their families, and we recognize the sacrifices they have made for our country. In November, our branches host programs in honor of our veterans as a way of saying "thank you" for their dedication to our country and its people.
