POSITION DESCRIPTION

Position Title:

Maintenance and Custodial Assistant

Reports To:

Director of Operations

<u>Supervisory Responsibilities:</u>

No supervisory responsibilities.

Location of Work:

Reports to an assigned branch or office of the Lafourche Parish Public Library. May travel to library branches throughout the parish as needed or assigned.

Hours of Work:

Full time (36-40 hours per week) or part time (up to 29 hours per week). Position is non-exempt, thus incumbent is subject to overtime/comp time provisions. Work schedule may include evening and weekend assignments.

Position Purpose:

Performs a variety of maintenance/custodial/janitorial duties.

Essential Functions:

- 1. Dusts furniture, shelves, and equipment. Vacuums, sweeps, mops, waxes, polishes floors. Washes walls, woodwork, blinds, shades, etc.
- 2. Cleans and mops restrooms and ensures adequate supplies.
- 3. Cleans up and maintains exterior of buildings. Picks up litter and sweeps walks around library entrances.
- 4. Changes light bulbs, replaces or cleans air conditioner filters, and reports need for building repair immediately.
- 5. Empties trash cans and wastebaskets and replaces trash bags.
- 6. Cleans showcases and windows.
- 7. Cuts grass throughout the parish as needed.
- 8. Sprays for insects.
- 9. Cleans library vehicles and performs minor maintenance on them.

- 10. Performs delivery service throughout the library system as required. This includes the regular operation of the courier route.
- 11. Move furniture and equipment.

Secondary Duties:

- 1. May assist with setting up displays or refreshments for library programs or meetings.
- 2. May occasionally run library errands as requested or assigned.
- 3. Performs minor carpentry, plumbing, electrical, and other maintenance or construction tasks.
- 4. May occasionally paint interiors and exteriors of buildings.
- 5. Keeps track of supplies available and needed. Performs some sort of inventory process. Make requests for needed supplies as needed.
- 6. Performs other duties as requested or assigned.

Physical Requirements:

Physical agility to stand, bend, stoop, climb, reach and lift objects weighing up to 50 pounds. Visual acuity to see and read instructions and directions.

Minimum Requirements:

Knowledge of and experience with cleaning materials, equipment, methods, and procedures. Ability to understand and follow simple oral and/or written instructions. Knowledge of the use and care of cleaning equipment. Ability to perform minor carpentry, plumbing, electrical, and other maintenance or construction tasks with little supervision and demonstration.
