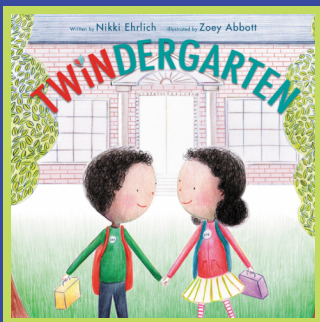
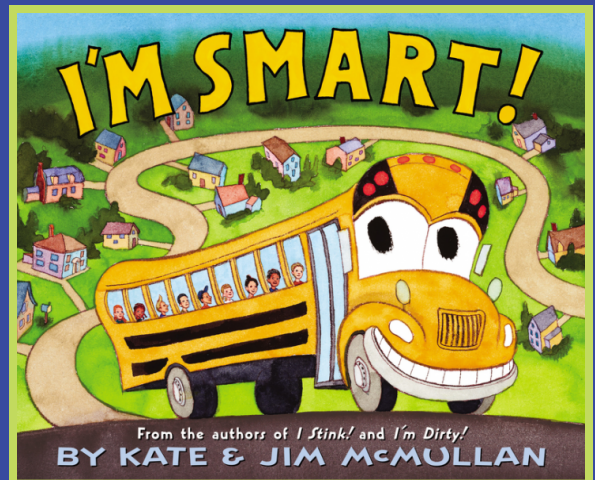
## Barkus *by Patricia MacLachlan*

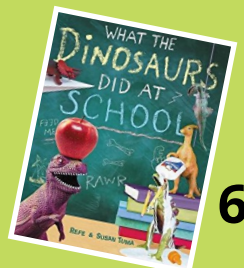
## Twindergarten *by Nikki Ehrlich*

Catch Up on Alison Weir's epic series, *Six Tudor Wives*. Books 1 & 2 are currently available at your LPPL!

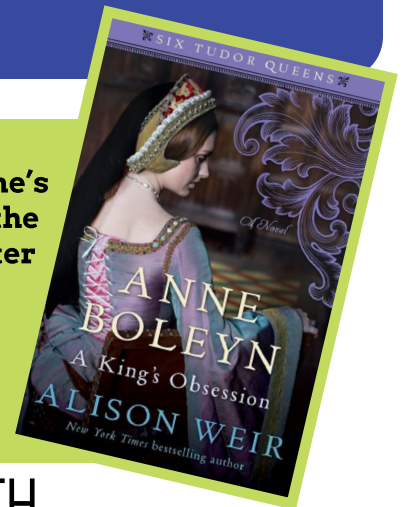

Weir's storytelling brings to light many aspects of Katherine's tumultuous life that are often absent in pop culture, and we get a more complete picture of the "True Queen."

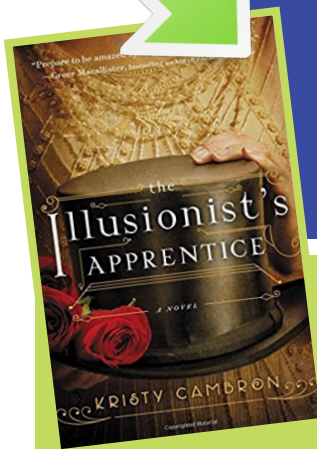
